- Coordinate with eNGOs and Community Relations Manager to develop volunteer opportunities
- Work with EAA to launch Wakefern's "Project Green" (internal sustainability program) including:
- Development of company-wide communications plan
- Creation of Intranet Sustainability micro-site
- Tracking of Associates PSP (personal sustainability pledge)
- Write on-line stores detailing the sustainability initiatives of Wakefern divisions (sharing of best practices division-wide)
