Its transportation fleet, one of the largest private fleets on the east coast, consists of 400 tractors and 2,000 trailers, and travels more than 35 million miles annually.

This internship position is a great opportunity for a student majoring in Supply Chain, Logistics, Industrial Engineering, Business Management, or another related field to gain hands-on experience working with Wakefern's Logistics team. During this internship, the intern will be exposed to transportation, inventory control, warehouse operations, industrial engineering and customer service. Exposure to these various areas and responsibilities within them will ultimately accelerate the development of core skills including leadership, professional skills, and general business knowledge.

Responsibilities are inclusive of but not limited to:

- Transportation experience will include dispatch, routing, safety, compliance, fleet/ mobile maintenance and inbound freight
