This internship position is a great opportunity for a student with an inherent interest in Quality Assurance and the processes Wakefern goes through to maintain their goods. Intern will gain hands on experience working with Wakefern's Quality Assurance team.

The Intern Product Inspector will be responsible for performing routine and thorough inspections of all inbound receiving's of perishable foods to ensure the quality, wholesomeness, proper labeling and fair packaging of goods purchased for the ShopRite members. They will also monitor and record the daily activities under the Seafood HACCP plans. Additionally, they will perform daily sanitation inspection of Warehouse and processing facilities.

Responsibilities are inclusive of but not limited to:

- Representative inspection of 14,000,000 cases during the summer months of product entering the perishables warehouses
- Gathering and organizing shellfish documentation to comply with the requirements of the National Shellfish Sanitation Program
- Monitoring and completing documentation as required under the federally mandated seafood HACCP regulation
- Ensuring that goods purchased for the membership conform to all established specifications, standards and PACA requirements.

To be considered a candidate must meet the minimum qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must have completed 24 college credits with a 2.9 cumulative GPA or better
- Must be currently enrolled in undergraduate or graduate school for fall of 2011
- Successful completion of a substance abuse test and background check required
- Strong MS Office skills (Excel, Word and PowerPoint required. Knowledge of Lotus Notes and Access a plus.)
- Valid driver's license and flexibility with regard to travel required
- Strong interpersonal, analytical and customer service skills with the ability to multitask and manage time effectively
